RUMPKE REAR DOOR SERVICE

Bancroft has a limited number of rear door garbage pick-up service being offered by our waste management contractor Rumpke at no cost to Bancroft residents. This service is for the garbage container only. The container will be retrieved by the Rumpke driver from the back door, emptied and returned. This does not include recycling or yard waste. The service will be granted on a needs basis for those that have difficulty taking the garbage container to the street. If you wish to apply for this service, please contact our City Clerk Shannon Tuthill or go to the city website, www.cityofbancroft.org, for an application. Upon receipt of the application the Commissioner of Public Services will be notified and your service can start soon after.

RUMPKE

Our collection days will not be affected by Columbus Day or Veterans Day Recycling collection days for October and November are Mondays 10/2, 10/16, 10/23, 11/6 and 11/20.
