## **RUMPKE REAR DOOR SERVICE**

This service is for the garbage container only. The container will be retrieved by the Rumpke driver from the back door, emptied and returned. This does not include recycling or yard waste. There will be no garbage pickup on Christmas Day, Monday, 12/25 or New Year's Day 1/1. Collection will be on Tuesday 12/26 and Tuesday 1/2. There will be no delay for Martin Luther King Day 1/15. Recycling collection days for December and January are Mondays 12/11, 12/26, 1/8, and 1/22. Yard debris will be picked every Monday in December. Starting in January vard debris will only be picked up the second Monday of the Month (1/8). Rumpke will no longer pick up yard debris left in plastic bags. Questions, contact Rumpke at 568-3800.
