These are some important questions. Did you know that the east end of Jefferson County has been thieves preferred target for unlocked cars, open garages and unlocked homes? What can you do to help?

- 1. Make sure you lock your car and don't have anything valuable showing.
- 2. Please keep your garage door closed at all times.
- 3. Lock your house.
- 4. Keep the exterior of your house and driveway lit up at night.
- 5. If you see something, then say something. Call 911 if you see something suspicious.
- 6. Consider getting security cameras. Thieves hate to be on video.
