Important Dates

Thursday, Jan. 23 and Friday, Jan. 24: Rumpke will drop off one 95-gallon garbage can and one 65-gallon recycling can between January 23 and 24.

Monday, Jan. 27: Anytime Waste Management will collect both their recycling

and trash bins after pickup on this date. Please leave your Anytime cans on the street until they collected by Anytime. If Anytime does not honor these dates as spelled out in our agreement, residents are asked to keep cans out as long as it takes for Anytime to pickup bins.

Monday, Feb. 3: Trash services from Rumpke will begin. On this date, trash and yard waste will be picked up.

Monday, Feb. 10: Rumpke will pick up trash and recycling.

Monday, March 9: Rumpke will pick up March yard waste collection.

Ongoing dates

Trash collection will continue to be every Monday.

Recycling collection will continue to be every other Monday. Upcoming dates include:

February 10 February 24 March 9 March 23

Weekly yard waste collection beings the first Monday in April.

What can I recycle?

Rumpke shall collect the following recyclables:

Aluminum cans Aluminum foil and foil food containers Tin and bi-metal food cans Steel food and aerosol cans Plastic bottles and jugs Glass bottles and jars Telephone books Office and computer paper Paperboard and beverage carrying cases Brown paper grocery bags Newsprint Magazines and catalogs Corrugated cardboard (2'x2' bundles) Gift and cereal boxes.
