MINUTES FROM JANUARY 15, 2020 SPECIAL BANCROFT MEETING

The special meeting for the City of Bancroft, KY was called to order by Mayor pro tem Ed Evers at 8:00 P.M on Wednesday, Thursday, January 15, 2020 at Episcopal Church Home. Mayor Pro tem informed everyone present that the purpose of this meeting is the discuss the new Rumpke contract for trash collections.

Commissioner Chumbley made a motion to approve the Rumpke contract with start date February 3, 2020 pursuant to the terms of their bid on April 3, 2019. Commissioner Schapker seconded motion. Discussion the contract states February 1 but the first Monday would be February 3.

Commissioner Chumbley noted this is the same contract we previously had with from 2019. There is a provision for a \$500 delivery fee to the city.

Rumpke to deliver cans to residents January 23 and/or 24th. Rumpke is prepared to mail out to residents a notice of the new service with a calendar.

Anytime will pick up trash cans January 27th. Residents to leave cans out until Anytime has a chance to pick them all up.

Question was raised about the possibility of a second recycling bin. Commissioner Chumbley said to just call Rumpke and request a second can.

Resident also asked about yard debris pickup and feels it should be weekly by March.

All in favor and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Chumbley made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Commissioner Borders seconded. All in favor and the meeting was adjourned at 8:19 pm.
