

ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 2020

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 91.44 IN CHAPTER 91 "STREETS AND SIDEWALKS", SUBSECTION .40 ET SEQ. "OBSTRUCTIONS" IN THE CITY OF BANCROFT, CODE OF ORDINANCES,

WHEREAS, the City of Bancroft has determined and hereby declares that it is necessary, desirable, and in the public interest of the City to regulate where residents may place temporary containers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bancroft wishes to ensure that such containers do not damage the pavement of its streets; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bancroft wishes to ensure that such containers do not inhibit or obstruct traffic or movement on its streets or sidewalks.

Wherefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BANCROFT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The City of Bancroft enacts the following ordinance:

§ 91.44 PLACEMENT OF TEMPORARY CONTAINERS

No person, without prior written permission from the City of Bancroft Commissioners, shall cause any temporary container, including but not limited to dumpsters, Bagsters, PODs, any temporary facility (such as temporary offices or restrooms), or shipping containers, to be placed, parked, or stationed on any street, alley, sidewalk, or other public way within the City of Bancroft. Each 24-hour period or part thereof that any temporary container is permitted to remain upon the public way shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
