

Congratulations to Mayor Jeff Magers who was presented the Level II - Excellence in City Governance certificate on July 1 from the Kentucky League of Cities (KLC). On November 4th, KLC representative Jessica Graves traveled to Bancroft to present the certificate to Mayor Magers. City Governance Certificates are presented to city officials who voluntarily attend KLC training courses. The Level II certificate requires the previous achievement of the Level I Achievement in City Governance certificate and an additional 29 hours of approved courses and one hour of ethics training.

## For immediate police assistance:

- 1. Emergency: Dial 911
- 2. Non-emergency police assistance: Dial 311

## For non-urgent neighborhood concerns:

 Call our police line at (502) 263-3663. Leave a voicemail with your name and phone number. Chief Yeager will call you back when he is on-duty.

For your safety, please call 911 or 311 to have police dispatched. If Chief Yeager is working, then they will dispatch him to help you, otherwise, they will dispatch a Metro police officer. Do not personally seek out Chief Yeager to get assistance for an emergency.

## **CRIME PREVENTION**

Chief Yeager works hard to keep Bancroft safe. Here are a few of his simple crime prevention tips.

- Turn on your porch lights and exterior lights at night.
- Keep your doors locked, even in the daytime.
- Lock your car doors and remove valuables from your cars, even if locked.
- Keep your garage door closed, especially at night.
- If you see something suspicious, then say something.
- Call 911 if you see a prowler.
