## **March Notes from the Mayor**

On March 1, I administered the oath of office to David Mudd as the new Bancroft Police Chief. As he patrols the city, I encourage you to stop and welcome Chief Mudd to Bancroft. Chief Mudd comes to us with over 30 years of police experience here in Kentucky. He has worked at several police departments and is retired from the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office. Immediately before becoming our police chief, he worked as a part-time officer

for Heritage Creek Police Department in Jefferson County, and he worked as the Law Enforcement Liaison for Kentucky Kingdom. Chief Mudd is an advocate of community policing, one of many reasons he was selected for the job. He is a trained police bike officer and has indicated he wants to periodically use his police bike skills to patrol Bancroft when warmer weather allows. Chief Mudd has his own police mountain bike and associated equipment, so he is ready to ride whenever the opportunity is right.

### **HOW CAN WE CONTACT THE POLICE?**

### For immediate police assistance:

- 1. Emergency: Dial 911
- 2. Non-emergency police assistance: Dial 311

### For non-urgent neighborhood concerns:

 Call our police line at (502) 263-3663. Leave a voicemail with your name and phone number.
 Chief Mudd will call you back when he is on-duty.

For your safety, please call 911 or 311 to have police dispatched. If Chief Mudd is working, then they will dispatch him to help you, otherwise, they will dispatch a Metro police officer. Do not personally seek out Chief Mudd to get assistance for an emergency.

### **CRIME PREVENTION**

Here are a few of his simple crime prevention tips.

- Turn on your porch lights and exterior lights at night.
- Keep your doors locked, even in the daytime.
- Lock your car doors and remove valuables from your cars, even if locked.
- Keep your garage door closed, especially at night.
- If you see something suspicious, then say something.
- Call 911 if you see a prowler.
