**CITY OF BANCROFT
MUNICIPAL ORDER NUMBER 2, SERIES 2026
A MUNICIPAL ORDER FOR REAPPOINTMENT OF CHIEF DAVID MUDD AS A
BANCROFT POLICE OFFICER.**

WHEREAS In accordance with KRS 95.022, Employment of Retired Police Officers, the City of Bancroft City Commission hereby reappoints Chief David Mudd, a retired officer participating in the County Employment Retirement System (CERS), for a period of one year as an officer of the Bancroft Police Department with the Rank of Police Chief. The effective date is July 1, 2026, and ends on June 30, 2027.

Consistent with the requirements of KRS 95.022, Chief Mudd will receive compensation in accordance to the standard procedures applicable to the City of Bancroft, and his employment is based upon need as determined by the Bancroft City Commission. Chief Mudd shall continue to receive all retirement and health insurance benefits to which he is entitled from the County Employment Retirement System (CERS).

In complying with KRS 95.022, the City of Bancroft shall not provide Chief Mudd with retirement and health insurance benefits and shall not pay employer contributions or retiree health expense reimbursements to the County Employment Retirement System (CERS).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY:

At the May 2026 City of Bancroft Commission meeting, the Bancroft City Commission approved this order.

This Municipal Order shall take effect upon its passage and approval as required by law.

Police Commission Notes, May 2026

Chief Mudd will not be in attendance for the May meeting. We likely will have Lyndon Police in the area during that time period however. We have agreed to renew our contract for the Flock cameras for the next year. It admittedly is expensive but can be seen as an additional set of eyes on our city, 24/7.

During this last month the Chief and I along with some commissioners were recipients of an email sent by someone to many city mayors and police chiefs. (8 pages of email addresses). After discussion with the city attorney, it was decided to ignore it principally it made allegations of occurrences in the past, and in the Elizabethtown vicinity.

We still have a lot of “overtime” pay available from the ARPA funds that the Chief will continue to use which is great for overnight surveillance.

ORDINANCE #1, SERIES 2026. AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BANCROFT,
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY,

RELATING TO THE 2026 REAL PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, the City of Bancroft Code of Ordinances provides for taxation in Chapter 36, and WHEREAS, the rate and location for payment shall be established by annual ordinance:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bancroft, Commonwealth of Kentucky, all taxes shall be due and payable as follows:

Section 1. The City hereby levies an annual ad valorem tax on all real and personal property at the rate of .285 cents per \$100 assessed valuation.

Section 2. If taxes are paid by October 15, 2026, the ad valorem (gross tax) less a discount of fifteen percent (15%) shall be due.

Section 3. Said taxes not paid by the due date of December 1, 2026, are delinquent and shall be due and payable as follows:

If paid by December 31, 2026, the full amount of ad valorem (gross tax) plus interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum from the due date until paid, plus a penalty of two percent (2%) shall be due.

If paid after December 31, 2026, the full amount of the ad valorem (gross tax) plus interest at a rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum from the due date until paid plus an additional penalty of fifteen percent (15%) shall be due.

Section 4. All payments shall be mailed to the Treasurer, City of Bancroft, 4949 Old Brownsboro Road, #243, Louisville, KY 40222

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
