BOAT AND TRAILER REMINDER

The commission would like to remind residences of Bancroft City Ordinance 150.03 (E) No mobile home, trailer, camper, recreational vehicle, basement, tent, shack, garage, or other outbuilding placed or erected in the subdivision at any time shall be used as a residence or place of business, temporarily or permanently. During any calendar year no mobile home, recreational vehicle, trailer, camper, boat, or truck shall be left parked on the property, or on any street in the city for a period exceeding an aggregate total of 24 hours.
