GOOD NEIGHBORLY REMINDERS

The Commission would like to remind residents of Section 72 of Bancroft ordinances. This covers areas of not parking for more than 24 hours on the street and not blocking your neighbor's driveway. Please as a courtesy even though it is not specified in section 72, do not park across from the entrance of someone's driveway. We have received several complaints of people parking across the street from the entrance of a driveway making it extremely hard to back out of their driveway. Thank you for any help that you can give your neighbors on this.

We have received complaints regarding dogs running loose in the city. This is not only a violation of Bancroft City Ordinances but also Louisville Metro Ordinances. Please remember **DOGS RESTRAINED BY INVISIBLE FENCES.**

According to Louisville Metro Ordinance § 91.001(b) all invisible fences must be clearly identified with a sign and the owner of the dog must be present.

Please report any violators immediately to Police Chief Yeager and they will be cited. If he's not available contact Animal Control at (502) 574-2111 option #5.
