

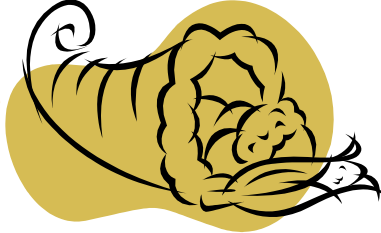

RUMPKE REAR DOOR SERVICE

Bancroft has a limited number of rear door garbage pick-up service being offered by our waste

management contractor Rumpke at no cost to Bancroft residents. This service is for the garbage container only. The container will be retrieved by the Rumpke driver from the back door, emptied and returned. This does not include recycling or yard waste. The service will be granted on a needs basis for those that have difficulty taking the garbage container to the street. If you wish to apply for this service, please contact our City Clerk Shannon Tuthill or go to the city website, www.cityofbancroft.org, for an application. Upon receipt of the application the Commissioner of Public Services will be notified and your service can start soon after.

SAFETY TIPS AND REMINDERS FROM CHIEF YEAGER

This goes directly to Chief Yeager and he keeps a record of it so if there is an emergency he can contact you. If you do not have access to email or would prefer to fill out the house watch form, just contact Clerk Tuthill. **If you need immediate police assistance please dial 911.** If Chief Yeager is on duty he will be dispatched and if not, Louisville Metro will be contacted.
