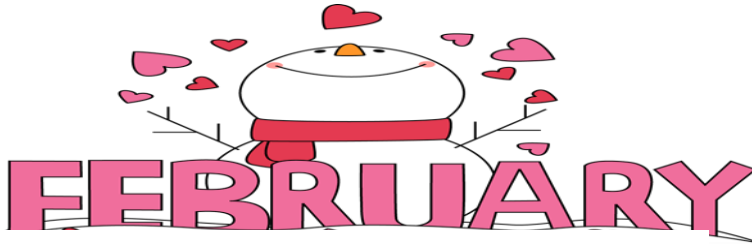

VEHICLES PARKED ON STREET

As a courtesy to your neighbors and for the safety of children and other residents, please remember not to leave cars parked on street for extended periods of time or across from the entrance of someone's driveway. City of Bancroft, Code of Ordinances, "§72.06 prohibits vehicles from being parked on the street for more than 24 hours.

Snowy Streets

The arrival of cold weather could bring more snow or ice. The City of Bancroft has a contract to salt when icy and remove snow when we get 3 inches or more at one time.

5. If you see something, then say something. Call 911 if you see something suspicious.
6. Consider getting security cameras. Thieves hate to be on video.
7. Watch out for your neighbors.
