As a courtesy to your neighbors and for the safety of children and other residents, please remember not to leave cars parked on street for extended periods of time. City of Bancroft, Code of Ordinances, §72.06 prohibits vehicles from being parked on the street for more than 24 hours.

Please remember dogs must be on leashes at all times. Dogs allowed to bark for long periods of time are considered a nuisance as well. **Please also clean up after your pets.**
