If you misplaced or feel you did not receive the bill, please contact Clerk Tuthill right away for another copy. Remember, it is your responsibility to send a copy to your mortgage company.

FRIENDLY REMINDER Bancroft City Ordinance 50.16 requires residents to remove empty garbage/recycle/yard waste cans from street-side by midnight on the day of pick up. If Rumpke fails to pick up your garbage/recycle/yard waste, first call Rumpke (568-3800) to request pick up, then call or email the City Commissioner for Public Services (see list of city officials on the right).

Our collection days will not be affected by Veterans Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas or New Year's Day. Recycling collection days for November and December are Mondays 11/12, 11/26, 12/10 and 12/24. Yard debris will be picked every Monday as well. Rumpke will no longer pick up yard debris left in plastic bags. Questions, contact Rumpke at 568-3800.
