SAFETY TIPS AND REMINDERS FROM CHIEF YEAGER

Please make sure your house number is clearly visible from the street. Always keep your garage doors closed and your car doors locked and ensure that bicycles, mowers, ladders, etc. are kept secured. Don't give thieves the temptation. **Please if you need police assistance dial 911!** If Chief Yeager is on duty he will be dispatched and if not, Louisville Metro will be contacted. Chief Yeager will then keep a record of this so if there is an emergency he can contact you.
