### NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING

As you may have heard on the news, Louisville Metro Mayor Fischer has proposed an increase of the insurance premium tax rate that would affect our city as well. The Bancroft City Commission needs to act immediately to ensure your insurance premium tax dollars are used to support the City of Bancroft. This requires a change to our insurance premium tax ordinance to match the new Louisville Metro tax rate. There will be a Special Meeting of the Bancroft City Commission on **Tuesday**, **March 12**, **2019**, **at 7:00 PM** in the 2nd floor conference room of the Episcopal Church Home, 7504 Westport Rd. The first reading of "Ordinance Revision to Chapter 112 Insurance Companies to amend the insurance premium tax rate" will occur at the special meeting.

# DOES YOUR MAILBOX NEED ATTENTION?

Please note the following tips from the United States Postal Service.

Mailboxes take a beating from the weather, so we recommend an annual mailbox checkup to avoid damage to your mail or difficulty identifying your address.

- Tighten loose hinges on the door
- Take care of rusty or loose parts
- Replace missing or faded house numbers
- Keep the path to your box clear

#### **RUMPKE**

Recycling collection days for March and April are Mondays 3/4, 3/18, 4/1, 4/15 and 4/29. Yard debris will be picked every Monday as well. Rumpke will no longer pick up yard debris left in plastic bags. Questions, contact Rumpke at 568-3800.

FRIENDLY REMINDER Bancroft City Ordinance 50.16 requires residents to remove empty garbage/recycle/yard waste cans from street-side by midnight on the day of pick up. If Rumpke fails to pick up your garbage/recycle/yard waste, first call Rumpke

## SAFETY TIPS AND REMINDERS FROM CHIEF YEAGER

If you are planning a trip. Please email Chief Yeager with your address, emergency contact information, dates you are away and if anyone will be at your home. Chief Yeager will then keep a record of this so if there is an emergency he can contact you.

WET WEATHER! Just a reminder that if you have a sewer grate in front of your house, please keep it clear. Failure to do this can potentially cause big problems when it rains, flooding your neighbors downhill and possibly the roads. Also make sure your gutters are functioning properly and free of debris.
