I hope that everyone has been staying well during the COVID-19 pandemic. There are Bancroft residents who have been serving as healthcare professionals, public safety workers, and in critical service positions that help us sustain life. We again thank you and wish you safety and good health as you provide services we all need. Governor Brashear has set in motion a phased plan for reopening businesses and returning to normal life. Hopefully, his plan proceeds without delay.

On Wednesday, April 29 we held a public hearing on the use of our Municipal Road Aid Funds we have saved for many years to repave Bancroft roads this summer. The meeting was held on Zoom. That step was required before we select a contractor at the May City Commission meeting. In addition, we will be presenting the first reading of

the 2020-2021 Budget and Tax ordinances.

The City Commission Meeting will be on Thursday, May 14, 2020, at 7:00 PM. Since Governor Steve Beshear's executive order to cease all in-person governmental operations remains in place, we will once again hold the City Commission meeting on Zoom.

I am often asked questions about several city ordinances. Here are some facts about these ordinances.

1. If you plan to build a fence or complete another building project on your property, you must submit a Building Permit Application. We hope to have that application posted on the web site, but until then just send me an email and I will send you the application and a copy of the Building Permit Process.
2. If you rent your Bancroft home, you must submit a rental application. That form and procedures are on the city website. This must be completed annually and any time there is a change in tenants.
3. If you plan to obtain a dumpster for major home renovations, you must place the dumpster in your driveway. Placing the dumpster on the street is prohibited. There are a few exceptions to that based on the configuration of your driveway and the location of your home.

Contact us if you have any questions.

Currently, 79.5% of Bancroft homes have responded to the U.S. Census. We rank 244 of 19,146 cities in the U.S. in the completion of the census. This is an excellent response. Let's try to make it 100%. Please complete the census information you have been sent by the U.S. Census Bureau. It is important for our city to obtain complete and accurate census information.

Please continue to remain vigilant regarding car break-ins. Lock your car and remove or place items of value in your trunk. While there have been no recent thefts in Bancroft, in August there were two reported cases on the Louisville end of Greenlawn Road near Herr Lane.

HOW CAN WE CONTACT THE POLICE?

For immediate police assistance:

1. Emergency: **Dial 911**
2. Non-emergency police assistance: **Dial 311**

For non-urgent neighborhood concerns:

1. Call our police line at **(502) 263-3663**. Leave a voicemail with your name and phone number. Chief Yeager will call you back when he is on-duty.

For your safety, please call 911 or 311 to have police dispatched. If Chief Yeager is working, then they will dispatch him to help you, otherwise, they will dispatch a Metro police officer. Do not personally seek out Chief Yeager to get assistance for an emergency.

CRIME PREVENTION

Chief Yeager works hard to keep Bancroft safe. Here are a few of his simple crime prevention tips.

- Turn on your porch lights and exterior lights at night.
- Keep your doors locked, even in the daytime.
- Lock your car doors and remove valuables from your cars, even if locked.
- Keep your garage door closed, especially at night.
- If you see something suspicious, then say something.
- Call 911 if you see a prowler.
